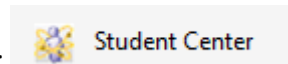

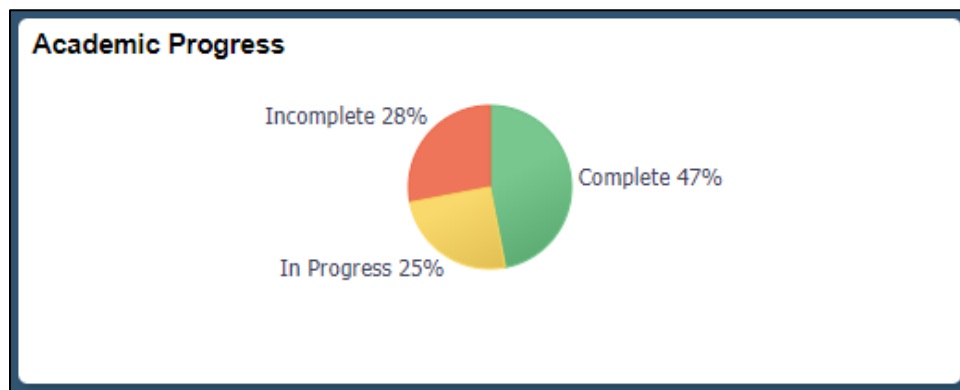
1. Log into **MyCLC** at the bottom of the CLC Website:

2. Click on the **Academic Progress** tile on the Student Homepage:



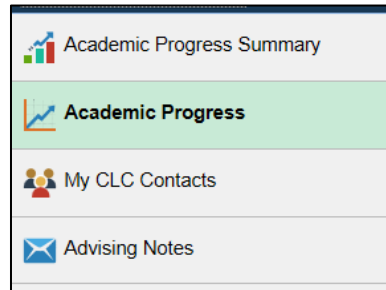
3. The **Academic Progress Summary** page provides a snapshot of your total progress towards degree/certificate completion.
