- 1 A TB 1-Step Test (\$10) is required each year after receiving the TB 2-Step or TSpot for all continuing Health Career Students until completion of program.
- 2 NA students need to show proof of 2 MMR vaccinations and 2 Varicella vaccinations OR documentation of the disease(s). If they cannot show proof of vaccinations, positive titers will be accepted.
- If titers show student is not immune, booster shot(s) are required. CLC Health Services' cost for the MMR is \$105, Tdap is \$42, and Hepatitis B is \$46 each. The Hepatitis B Vaccination is a set of three immunizations over a 6 month period. (CLC Health Services costs listed are as of 6/7/22 and are subject to change.) CLC Health Services does not offer the Varicella vaccination.
- 4 NA student need Covid booster(s) if eligible. For Phlebotomy, proof of Covid vaccinations are needed only for PBT116.
- Flu shots required for fall and spring semester NUR110 sections. Phlebotomy students must show proof of a flu vaccination from the previous 12 months to register, and will be required to get upcoming season's flu shot when available. PHM students' clinicals are in the summer so a flu shot is not required.
