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¹EIU – Must take MTH 122 College Algebra or earn a Math score of 26 or higher on the ACT.

²EIU – May take PSY 121 or ANT (121 or 221) or SOC 222 or PSC 222.

³EIU – EDU 121 & 124 & 242 is equivalent to EIU's ELE 2050. EDU 242 serves to satisfy the clinical hours which is a licensure requirement covered by EIU's ELE 2050.

⁴ISU - Must take a course in College Algebra or show proficiency by taking ALEKS test at ISU.

⁵ISU - GEG 122 or 123 may be used to fulfill ISU's Global Studies requirement and the Geography requirement simultaneously.

⁶ISU – Take EDU 224 if pursuing ESL endorsement.

⁷NLU – By taking ECE 251 and 253 and either EDU 124 or PSY 222, that will fulfill NLU's EDU 299 Practicum I Child Development.

⁸NEIU – Math requirement is 9 credit hours: students taking MTH 121 and 221 at CLC are required to take MATH 151 at NEIU upon transfer. May take MATH 149 & 150 at NEIU.

⁹NEIU – Six hours of **Fine Arts** required; no more than one course from any department can be used to complete this requirement. Nine hours of **Humanities** required; 3 hours must be **English Lit**. No more than two courses from any department can be used to complete this requirement.

¹⁰NIU – MTH 122 or higher OR placement into higher than MTH 122.

¹¹NIU – MUS 126 & 127 or contact an NIU Elementary Education advisor for *possible* course substitutions.

¹⁴UIUC – EDU 124 or ECE 124 or PSY 222 or EDU 225 (EDU 225 can also fulfill the second Social and Behavioral Science requirement).

¹⁵UIUC – Students are required to complete through 2 years in high school or through the 2nd semester in college of a single foreign language for admission. For graduation, students will need to complete through 3 years in high school or through the 3rd semester in college.

¹⁶UIUC - ISBE Social Science Rubric: Select one course in four of the following: Anthropology, Economics, Geography, History, Global Studies, Political Science, Sociology and Psychology.

¹⁷UIC – It is recommended that you meet with a UIC College of Education advisor and use Transferology.com to view program requirements.

¹⁸UIC – Run a program with equivalencies in Transferology to view options for requirements for Understanding the Creative Arts.
